

Football Frequently Asked Questions

1. Are there any other costs or deposits associated?

There are no other equipment costs; however, there are a few deposits outlined below:

Each athlete registered to participate in "FOOTBALL" with TYFCA will be required to provide an equipment deposit of \$225.00. This deposit shall be made in the form of a check, payable to TYFCA and postdated for December 1st of this calendar year. All checks shall be destroyed upon verified equipment return.

Each registering family will be required to provide a volunteer deposit of \$200 dollars. This deposit will be required in the form of a check, postdated for December 1 of this calendar year. All checks shall be destroyed upon fulfillment of volunteer commitment, as outlined in the 2017 volunteer policy (policy will be published soon).

Each registering family will be required to provide a \$200 Fundraising Deposit. This deposit shall be made in the form of a check, payable to TYFCA and postdated for August 1 of this calendar year. All checks shall be destroyed upon fulfillment of compliance with the 2017 Fundraising policy (policy will be published soon).

2. Do I have to live in a certain location to sign-up with the Titans?

No. The Titans are not limited by a geographical area.

3. How often do the Titans practice?

We practice 3 nights a week for 2 hours a night. We typically practice from 6:15-8:15 PM Mon, Wed, Thur during the season which could also be the same PRE season.

5. TeamApp Registration

The 2019 Texas Titans now has their own Smartphone App. It'll keep you up-to-date with news, events, schedules and much more.

To get the full features of your teams App you need to download Team App onto your smartphone.

- You'll be sent an email to confirm your registration.
- Confirm registration
- Log in.
- Search for Texas Titans 2019
- Once you open Texas Titans 2019, go to Settings
- Go to Access Groups and request access to group(s) that apply to you.
- If you don't have a smartphone, notify the Titans Media Director so you can be added manually and you'll receive email notifications.

6. What ages can play?

The age of the tryout participant on August 1 is the age that should be used. Ages 5-12 are welcomed and age 4 with a signed wavier.

7. What are the age brackets for the different levels?

Ages athlete should be as of August 1 per division:

Freshman 4-6

Sophomore 7-8

Junior Varsity 9-10

Varsity 11-12

8. What's the cost?

The cost is \$325 for Football, which covers the cost of shoulder pads, helmet, practice uniform including T-Shirt & shorts. Game Uniform including compression shorts and shirt. Players will get to keep their practice T-Shirt, game uniform, compression shorts, and compression shirt. Helmet, shoulder pads, and practice uniforms will be turned in at the end of the season. Legacy players do not get a discount.

9. When and where are the games played?

Our games are played on Saturday and at locations around Houston. This can range from Tomball, Woodlands, Humble or as far as Beaumont.

10. When do games start?

Our first game is typically around the first week or second week in September.

11. When does practice start?

Typically, in June

12. When does the season start?

The regular season is in the fall with the first game typically in early September. Practice will start in June.

13. When registering, are IDs required for football players?

Yes, a valid Texas ID is required in order to register.

14. When will I know who will coach my son's team?

During registration we let people volunteer to be coaches. All new coaches and all past coaches must re-apply each year. The board will interview all the coaches that are interested in a head coaching position and select the best head coach for each level. The head coach is then responsible for filling his staff from people who have submitted applications to the board and have been approved as potential assistant coaches.

15. Where do the Titans Practice?

The Titans typically practice at The Farm League Park located just north of Spring Cypress off Stubner Airline. Please be aware this can change due to unforeseen circumstances
