

## Titans Youth Football and Cheer Volunteer Policy

As a not for profit organization, the Titans Youth Football and Cheer Association (TYFCA) relies heavily on the volunteer support that we receive from our families. All TYFCA families are required to participate in volunteer activities at games and other TYFCA events. Having our parents volunteer prevents the organization having to seek outside assistance to work our games, where TYFCA would be required to pay. This in turn allows us to maintain our registration fees at a minimum.

Each registering family will be required to provide a volunteer deposit of \$200 dollars. This deposit will be required in the form of a check, postdated for **November 1** of this calendar year. All checks will be securely held by the Registrar of the TYFCA. Upon completion of the regular season, checks will be destroyed providing the volunteer requirement has been met for the registering family. **A one-time buyout of \$250.00 may also fulfil this obligation.**

Each registering family will be required to help at minimum up to **3 times** for game day duties, or other events where the TYFCA need assistance, including but not limited to concessions, sidelines, entry gate, and/or fundraising events etc. (family fun day is not considered a volunteer event). The volunteer coordinator is the only person allowed to qualify volunteer activities outside of those listed here. **If you are not able to cover your scheduled spot, it is your responsibility to inform the volunteer coordinator.**

TYFCA will circulate an electronic sign up and required everyone to choose the event for which they would like to volunteer. We understand that conflicts will come up during the year so swapping of a date is permitted. If you do not sign up for a volunteer event or fail to meet the minimum obligation in any way, the TYFCA reserves the right to deposit the check. In addition to depositing the volunteer deposit, failure to meet the minimum volunteer obligation will result in loss of "member in good standing".

The TYFCA hopes it will never have to execute such a penalty but we need everyone to participate during the year to make a fantastic experience for all members of the Titan Nation. We truly rely on the help of every family to execute a great season that our children will remember positively. New families don't be scared to step in and help, its encouraged.

Lastly, due to the high costs to host football games, volunteers are required to pay the gate admission.

The Titans continue to appreciate the support of our wonderful families and look forward to another great season.
